INDONESIA - TRESNA WERDHA ELDERLY NURSERY

Tresna Werdha Elderly Nursery

Tresna Werdha Elderly Nursery is a Social House devoted to the elderly who cannot afford their own housing. It is a registered, non-governmental, non-religious and non-profit social service organization with the sole objective of serving people in need.

Destination Asia Indonesia's efforts were a contribution of both donations and time spent with the residents of the "Panti". Sharing stories of their youth while sharing a highly celebrated rice tower called Nasi Tumpeng. But the highlight of the day was by far the karaoke, where a mix of traditional and modern songs created a fun and lively break for the 31 residents.

The team donated:

- 100 kg of rice
- 10 kg of sugar
- 30 kg of vegetables
- 5 kg of coffee
- 150 eggs
- 20 liters of cooking oil
-and more!

6 staff dedicated a half day of their time at the nursery.

A generous donation of 2,500 USD was made by our in-house corporate and incentive guest, Ms. Sibylle Zillgens Coe from Launch Inc.

VIETNAM - THE SHELTER THIEN DUYEN

The Shelter Thien Duyen

The Shelter Thien Duyen in HCMC cares for over 100 disadvantaged children and homeless people. Many of the residents are orphaned children suffering from cerebral palsy.

Destination Asia Vietnam are organizing a Food Drive with collections taken at its office throughout May to then be donated to the shelter.

Destination Asia Vietnam organized a food drive to distribute essential items such as rice, salt, sugar, fish sauce, diapers, shampoo, and more to the Thien Duyen shelter. The team raised an amazing 35,000,000 VND (approximately 1,500 USD). They were able to purchase goods worth 25,000,000 VND and provided Mama Muoi with an additional 10,000,000 VND in cash. Co.opmart store supported the cause by offering special discount on all products purchased.

The team donated:

- 450** kg of rice
- 55** litres of cooking oil
- 60** kg of sugar
- 30** kg of salt
- 60** bottles of fish sauce
- 50** bottles of soya sauce
- 20** tubes of toothpaste

MALAYSIA - KECHARA SOUP KITCHEN

A not-for-profit and non-governmental organisation founded in 2008 in Penang, Kechara Soup Kitchen serve hot meals, dry food, fruits, drinks; and provide basic medical care and welfare aid to the homeless and disadvantaged within the community.

Destination Asia Malaysia together with an established NGO in Malaysia (Kechara Soup Kitchen) participated in food distribution over a period of three days. The food and drink is prepared at one of the centres and then handed out to those most in need whom have registered with the organisation.

We supported the soup kitchens by volunteering for three full days:

2 days volunteering at Penang Kechara Centre

200 meals prepared and handed out by our team.

1 day volunteering at Kuala Lumpur Kechara Centre

90 meals packed and handed out by our team.

THAILAND - RAJVITHI HOME FOR GIRLS

Rajvithi Home for Girls

The Rajvithi Home for Girls was established in order to provide assistance and development for orphans and disadvantaged children aged between 5 and 18. These children often lack guardians, are abandoned, living in poverty, being raised inappropriately, living in broken family, sexually exploited, or have parents serving a jail term.

Destination Asia Thailand and the team from head office in Bangkok, organized a food drive with a collection point in action from 8-25 May. In total, approximately 20 large boxes of food items were collected for donation.

SINGAPORE - WILLING HEARTS SOUP KITCHEN



Willing Hearts Soup Kitchen

A non-affiliated charity, Willing Hearts is wholly run by volunteers, apart from a handful of staff. It operates a soup kitchen that prepares, cooks and distributes about 7,000 daily meals to over 70 locations island wide.

16 staff from Singapore dedicated their time from 9am-1pm on 26 May

Destination Asia Singapore volunteered their time on 26 May by preparing ingredients, help pack lunch boxes, clean and wash dishes, and provide general help around the Willing Hearts Soup Kitchen as required.

HONG KONG - FOOD ANGEL



Food Angel

Food Angel rescues edible surplus food from different sectors of the food industry that would otherwise be disposed of as waste. The items are then prepared as meals in a central kitchen and redistributed to underprivileged communities in Hong Kong.

5 staff from Hong Kong dedicated their time from 9am-5pm on 13 June.
