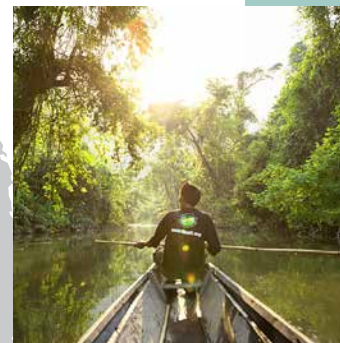
Northern Laos river cruise experience

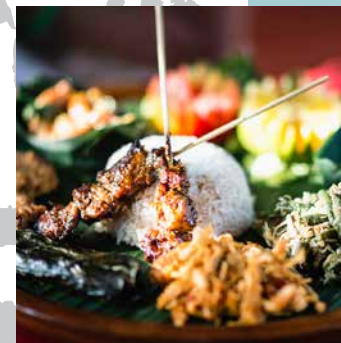
Chinatown and Little India
